ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990, section 80

Abatement Notice in respect of Noise Nuisance

To **Mrs J M Thorne**

Of **Splitz, 37 Quebec Street, Dereham, Norfolk, NR19 2DJ**

TAKE NOTICE that under the provisions of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 the **Breckland District Council** ("the Council")

being satisfied of the existence of noise amounting to a statutory nuisance under section 79(1)(g) of that Act at

residential properties within close proximity to Splitz, 37 Quebec Street, Dereham, Norfolk, NR19 2DJ

within the district of the said Council arising from

amplified music emanating from Splitz, 37 Quebec Street, Dereham, Norfolk, NR19 2DJ

HEREBY REQUIRE YOU, as the person responsible for the said nuisance with immediate effect from the service of this notice to **PROHIBIT** the recurrence of the same and

Ensure that amplified music does do not cause a Statutory Nuisance to nearby residents.

IF without reasonable excuse you contravene or fail to comply with any requirement of this notice you will be guilty of an offence under section 80(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990. A person who commits an offence on industrial, trade or business premises will be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £20,000.

The Council may also take proceedings in the High Court for securing the abatement, prohibition or restriction of the nuisance.
