I am writing to inform you that on 20<sup>th</sup> September 2018, the Inspector formally closed the hearing sessions, which formed part of the examination into the soundness of the Breckland District Council Local Plan. The examination will remain open until the Inspector's report has been submitted to the Council. However, he will not accept any further representations or evidence unless he specifically requests it. Further evidence or unsolicited material will be returned.

A number of Main Modifications (MMs) have been discussed during the hearing sessions and the Inspector may require further MMs to address soundness issues. The MM schedule and any additional information associated with the Sustainability Appraisal (SA) will be subject to a period of 6 weeks consultation, where everyone will have an opportunity to provide representations. The Inspector will consider the representations before coming to his final conclusions, which will be set out in his report.
