HOU 05 Pre-ambleThe statement 'Development ... will be limited' is imprecise and open to varying interpretations.

Paragraph 2The term 'appropriate' is vague and imprecise. NPPF says that Local Plans should be clear and give objective guidance. Paragraph 2 in this form does not. HOU 04 gives specific guidance on the overall increase in housing units during the life of the Plan. Why no similar guidance for HOU 05?

Paragraph 3Some expression of community support and identification of community benefit should be part of this Policy. Why does HOU 04 include this benefit for slightly larger villages? Both HOU 04 and HOU 05 deal with rural villages, differing only in population size. In terms of planning policy consistency they should be dealt with in the same way.

[Un-numbered paragraph] A blanket support for self-build is too wide sweeping.

Overall it is very disappointing that planning policy for the rural villages in Breckland - small in population but significant in terms of the character of our area - has ended up with this hacked about and incoherent jumble of poorly considered policies. The final insult of course is that even this policy has been published incorrectly!
