It remains Gladman's position that the identified housing target required is flawed as itfails to take adequate considerations of market signals as outlined in our previoussubmissions. We suggest that the significant affordability pressures currently facing the district are unlikely to be fulfilled without planning for uplift to the total housing provision.

As currently drafted, Gladman does not consider that this policy aligns with the requirements of the Framework.
