

**New Buckenham Neighbourhood Plan – Consultation Statement Review**

A generally clear set out and well-presented document, in terms of text and graphics, that sets out the approach taken by the Working Group to consult the local community on the Neighbourhood Plan. The main issue is the failure of a number of links to documents and webpages, which will either need to be corrected, or a list of the correct links provided or the copies of the information for the Independent Examiner.
