The redundant church is used sometimes, but has no real facilities, the pub has re-opened but may not be suitable. Again, these villagers have to travel to Foxley which is difficult for those without cars as the bus service is dire.

If Bintree had a polling place it would also serve Twyford.

All the villages have remote settlements around them which means many residents are outside normal acceptable walking distance. But as rural dwellers most have at least access to a car.
