### Checklist for final submission

When you submit your final plan to Breckland Council you must include:	
A map showing the area which your plan will cover- your Neighbourhood Area	
A consultation statement containing: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>– The people and bodies you have consulted on your plan</li><li>– An explanation how they were consulted</li><li>– Summaries of the main issues and concerns</li><li>– Details of how the issues have been considered and, where relevant, addressed in your plan</li></ul>	
The final Neighbourhood Plan	
Any accompanying Strategic Environmental Assessment and Habitat Regulations Assessment	
A statement outlining how your plan has met the required basic conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>– Have regards to national policy</li><li>– Contribute to sustainable development</li><li>– Be in general conformity with the Breckland Core Strategy (Local Plan)</li><li>– Not breaching and is compatible with EU obligations</li></ul>
